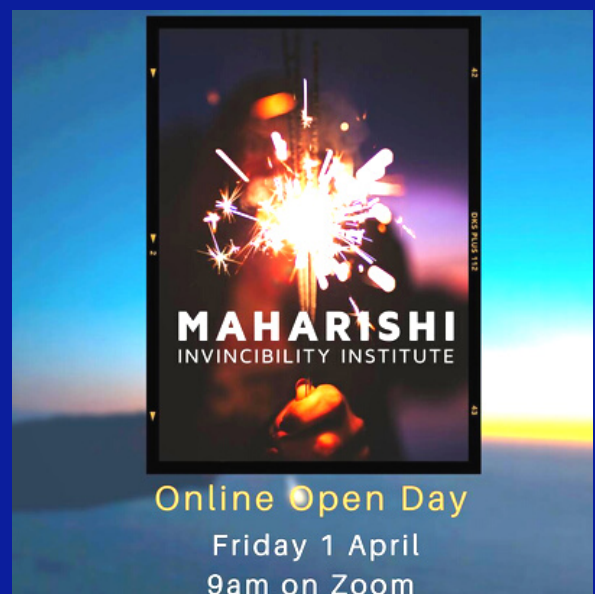

## Info on Maharishi Academies

1) Recruitment is done through work-study and Skills Department - soon will be moved to Career Center and Job Shop on 4th floor once up and running.

2) You will be required to have work experience as well as theory. The work experience depends on the academy stream and the academy sponsor.

NB: Students need to complete a full 12 months once they have joined an academy before they can change academies/streams.

The current policy is that students failing to complete the full qualification will not be eligible to join another academy/stream for a period of 12 months.

**TO APPLY:** Stay tuned for more info in future newsletters.

## There are 3 levels for Seta qualifications

**Level 1:** NQF3 in foundation. This is Informal Small Businesses (ISB) open to all foundation students generally within 1 - 6 months after they have started at MIU:

**Level 2:** GenMan NQF 5 in phase 2 - open to selected students who have successfully completed ISB. Selection is done by the Skills Department & subject to sponsorship from the Business Development Department.

**Level 3:** Academies (Financial Markets / Insurance / Digital/IT / Cyber Security / Business Advising / Facilitation / MII work/study / etc) - this is available to MIU students ONLY (certain exceptions: see below) & selection is based on attendance, participation in DFHP & academics. Students can do only one academy/stream at a time. Each qualification inside the academies takes 12 months to complete. Certain academies have a follow-on course for another 12 months such as Digital/IT and Insurance and can be done over a period of 24 months (NQF4: 12 months / NQF5: 12 months).

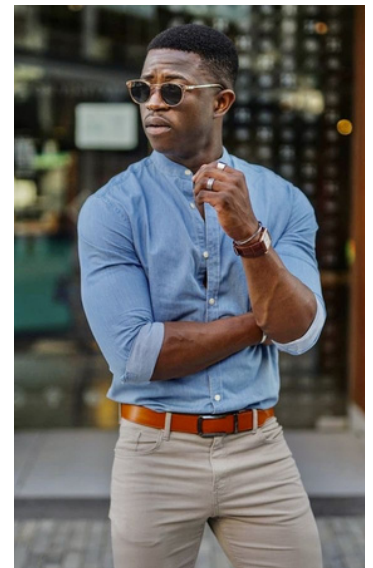
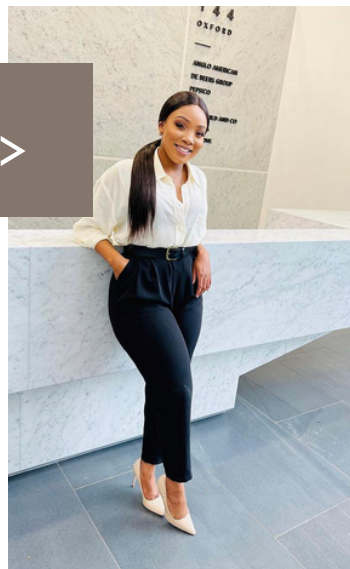
